Sir,

In inviting reference to the above, this is to inform you that Spent Pot Lining (SPL) consists of different parts. As advised by the Board, the Aluminum Smelters in the state of Odisha are separating SPL into different fractions during de-lining of pots & storing them separately under sheds. These fractions are Carbon Parts, Refractory Parts and Silicon Carbide Refractory Parts, which require different methods of treatment for further utilization having different usages. During de-lining, mixed fines are being generated which are co-processed by cement kilns operating inside and outside the state of Odisha.

So far, only Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) for Carbon and Silicon Carbide parts have been developed by CPCB which are available on the website of CPCB (<https://cpcb.nic.in/sop-for-hw-specific/>) (SOP 32: Utilization of Spent Pot Lining (SPL) generated from Primary Aluminium Smelting Industries (Revised), published in March 2021 & SOP 72: Pre-processing of Waste Silicon Carbide Refractory bricks from Pot Lining Waste generated from primary Aluminium smelters, published in December 2021). No SOP has yet been developed by CPCB for utilization of refractory part of SPL. Further in the SOP developed for SPL Carbon part, the proprietor (M/s Green Energy Resources, Sambalpur) who was a part in the development of this SOP, is protected through patent rights. Hence, it appears that at present no other actual user for utilization of Carbon Part of SPL except M/s Green Energy Resources, Sambalpur & M/s Regrow Transo Pvt. Ltd., Jharsuguda (obtained patent rights from the former unit) or Refractory Part is legally permitted under Rule 9 of the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.

It may be mentioned here that a policy guideline was framed by the Board for utilization of Hazardous Wastes generated in the State on the establishment of the unit by restricting the number of Actual Users and their installed capacity and interstate transportation of such wastes for utilization. However, such guidelines have been withdrawn. Now there is no specific restriction from the Board on issuance of Consent to Establish (CTE) and Authorization for



Hazardous Wastes Recycling Industries/ Actual Users under Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016. In accordance with the orders of the Hon'ble High Court of Orissa, the Board is to only ensure that the patent right of the petitioner unit i.e. M/s Green Energy Resources, Sambalpur is not compromised, and utilization of Spent Pot Lining (Carbon Part) generated from Primary Aluminum Smelting Industries will be regulated by Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) of CPCB under Rule-9 of the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) (HOWM) Rules, 2016. Office Order of the Board in this regard is enclosed as **Annexure-I**. In the existing SOP, the patent right of M/s Green Energy Resources, Sambalpur is protected. Therefore, to protect the patent rights, the utilizer of this particular SOP shall take permission from the patent holder and abide by the regulations stipulated for patents No. 343974, dtd. 22.09.2017 as per the provisions of the Patents Act, 1970.

Presently various proponents (M/s Persistent Aluminum Pvt. Ltd., Sambalpur and M/s Surya Metallics, Angul) are applying to the SPCB, Odisha for establishment of utilization of SPL (Carbon Part) with new technologies different from the technology mentioned in the existing SOP of CPCB and M/s Tekno Processors LLP, Sambalpur for SPL (Refractory Part). Further some entrepreneurs like M/s Alset Enterprises Pvt. Ltd., West Bengal has applied under rule 9 of the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) (HOWM) Rules, 2016 to CPCB for developing new SOP for utilization of SPL (Carbon Part).

Therefore, you can establish a processing unit for utilization of SPL-Carbon Part by adopting a different technology other than the technology mentioned in the existing SOP of CPCB and obtain CTE, CTO and authorization from Haryana State Pollution Control Board with permission from CPCB under rule 9 of HOWM Rules, 2016. Thereafter, you can apply for collection and transportation of SPL-Carbon Part from State of Odisha to Haryana for recycling and obtain authorization from SPCB, Odisha.





As advised by the Board, the Aluminum Smelters in the state of Odisha are separating SPL into different fractions during de-lining of pots & storing them separately under sheds. These fractions are Carbon Parts, Refractory Parts and Silicon Carbide Refractory Parts, which require different methods of treatment for further utilization having different usages. During de-lining, mixed fines are being generated which are co-processed by cement kilns operating inside and outside the state of Odisha.

So far, only Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) for Carbon and Silicon Carbide parts have been developed by CPCB which are available on the website of CPCB (<https://cpcb.nic.in/sop-for-hw-specific/>) (SOP 32: Utilization of Spent Pot Lining (SPL) generated from Primary Aluminium Smelting Industries (Revised), published in March 2021 & SOP 72: Pre-processing of Waste Silicon Carbide Refractory bricks from Pot Lining Waste generated from primary Aluminium smelters, published in December 2021). - 2) The Board may allow establishment / authorization of actual users / recyclers of Hazardous Waste (HW) inside the state up to a capacity 200% of generation of HW per annum and in case the hazardous waste cannot be utilized by the actual users inside the state or there is no such actual user operating in the state, the Board can authorize actual users of the other states for collection and interstate transportation of balance quantity of the HW to avoid accumulation of hazardous waste at the site of the Generator.
- 3) In case a single actual user unit is operating inside the state for recycling of a particular Hazardous Waste, the 2<sup>nd</sup> unit can be allowed to establish and operate to avoid monopoly, develop competitiveness and to ensure continuous utilization of hazardous waste even in case of breakdown of one of these units. The 2<sup>nd</sup> unit can come up in another district, but close to the other unit.
- 4) The technologies adopted for reuses, recycling, recovery, pre-processing, utilization and co-processing of Spent Pot Lining (SPL) of Aluminium Smelters should be vetted through a National Level Govt. Research Institutions like Jawaharlal Nehru Aluminium Research Development and Design Centre (JNARDDC)/ Institute of Minerals and Materials Technology (IMMT)/ National Environmental Engineering Research Institute (NEERI) to ensure authentic utilization of SPL in an environmentally sound manner, since SPL contains Cyanide and Fluoride and Toxic in nature. The Technology is required to be also approved by CPCB having SoP.

**AND WHEREAS**, the Policy adopted vide Office Order No. 8091, dtd. 13.08.2019 for regulating Consent to Establish and Authorization of Hazardous Waste Recycling Industries /Actual Users has been withdrawn through 127<sup>th</sup> Board Meeting held on 13.12.2023 vide Office Order dtd. 2686 dtd. 22.02.2023.

**AND WHEREAS**, the Hon'ble High Court has been pleased to stay the operation of Office order dtd. 22.02.2023 vide their order dtd. 21.03.2023 in the matter of WP© No. 7562/2023 – M/s. Green Energy Resources vs. State of Odisha & Ors. and the same is now subjudice before the Hon'ble High Court of Orissa. Hence the earlier Office Order No. 8091 dtd. 13.08.2019 referred above is still in force.

**NOW THEREFORE**, after considering the relevant records and in compliance to the direction dtd.06.06.2023 of the Hon'ble High Court of Orissa and the representation dtd.07.02.2023 which is annexed vide Annexure-1 of the Writ Petition has been looked into and it has been decided that, since the capacity of the Actual Users of Used Oil and Waste Oil in

the State has already been exceeded 200% of generation of Used Oil and Waste Oil in the State and there is no surplus of such hazardous wastes in the State; your application for authorization for collection, transportation, and utilization of Used Oil and/or Waste Oil is hereby refused until further order by the Hon'ble High Court of Orissa in the matter of WP© No. 7562/2023 – M/s. Green Energy Resources vs. State of Odisha & Ors..

Accordingly, your representation dtd. 07.02.2023 is herewith disposed of in the light of observations made in the foregoing paragraphs.



In inviting reference to the above, this is to inform you that Aluminium Smelters of Odisha are segregating the Spent Pot Lining (SPL) in to Carbon part and Refractory part. During such segregation activities, some mixed fines are also generated. The Aluminium Smelters are storing such hazardous wastes separately prior to disposal.

Central pollution control board (CPCB) has developed Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) for utilization of SPL (Carbon Part) for manufacturing of Carbon Mineral Fuel to be used as resource/energy recovery in Cement Kiln under Rule 9 of Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016(“Standard Operating Procedure and Checklist of Minimal Requisite Facilities – Utilization of Spent Pot Lining (SPL) generated from Primary Aluminium Smelting Industries of CPCB, March, 2017”). No SOPs has yet been developed for utilization of SPL (Refractory Part) and SPL (Mixed fines).

There are two Actual Users of SPL Carbon Part established in the state of Odisha and have obtained CTO and Authorization from the Board. There is no surplus generation of such wastes in the state. Similarly, there are 3 Nos. of Cement Kilns who have obtained CTO and Authorization from the Board for Co-processing of SPL (Mixed Fines). There is no surplus generation of such waste in the state also. Moreover, the matter regarding permitting

additional establishments of such Actual Users in the state or supply of such wastes to the Actual Users operating outside the state is now sub-judice with Hon'ble High Court of Odisha. So, in these circumstances, such hazardous wastes can not be allowed to be collected and transport from the state of Odisha. Further, it is understood that no SOPs for utilization of SPL (Refractory part) has yet been developed by CPCB. So, in absence of such SOPs, you are not supposed to collect and transport such wastes for recycling. Therefore, your request to authorize you for collection and transportation of SPL can not be considered at this stage.




