A Glimpse of International Day of Clean Air for Blue Skies-2024

State Pollution Control Board, Odisha celebrated the 5th International Day of Clean Air for Blue Skies-2024 with a theme “Invest in #CleanAirNow” in collaboration with the many stakeholders in seven non-attainment cities viz. Angul, Balasore, Bhubaneswar, Cuttack, Kalinga Nagar, Rourkela, and Talcher.

A total of 23 events were conducted including a bicycle rally, walkathon, plantation, technical presentation, awareness and cultural programme at various apartments and showcasing environmental awareness videos in 37 cinema halls across Odisha.

More than 2000 participants were presented in this programme and around 500 nos. of plants were planted in different locations. As per the mission LiFE mandate, all the participants have taken the mission LiFE pledge.

1. Introduction

Clean air is important for the health and day-to-day lives of people, while air pollution is the single greatest environmental risk to human health and one of the main avoidable causes of death and disease globally. According to the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP), air pollution is the world's biggest environmental killer. Data from the World Health Organization (WHO) indicates that air pollution is responsible for around seven million premature deaths each year through diseases such as lung cancer, acute respiratory infections and heart disease. In addition, air pollution disproportionately affects women, children and older persons. Air pollution doesn't only affect human health, it also negatively impacts the climate, economic growth and natural environment. Air pollution decreases the oxygen supply in our oceans, making it harder for plants to grow and as such, contributes to climate change.

In order to raise awareness and mobilise efforts against air pollution, the Second Committee of the 74th session of the United Nations (UN) General Assembly adopted a resolution on November 26, 2019, designating 7th September as the “*International Day of Clean Air for Blue Skies*”. The resolution stresses the importance of global awareness of air pollution and the need for robust actions to improve air quality. The day also highlights the negative impact of air pollution on human health, socio-economy, and work productivity.

Ministry of Environment, Forest, and Climate Change (MoEF&CC), New Delhi and Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) have decided to observe the International Day of Clean Air for Blue Skies in all the 131 non-attainment cities in India. Accordingly, the Forest, Environment and Climate Change Department (FE&CC), Govt. of Odisha and Odisha State Pollution Control Board (OSPCB) are organizing events in seven non-attainment cities of Odisha to raise the awareness of all stakeholders and general public to combat air pollution at large.

1.1 Yearly Themes and Activities

Since 2020, the international community has been celebrating International Day of Clean Air for Blue Skies with a different theme selected for each year as given below:

- 2020 Clean Air for All
- 2021 Healthy Air, Healthy Planet
- 2022 The Air We Share
- 2023 Together for Clean Air
- **2024 Invest in #CleanAirNow**

This year, the International Day of Clean Air for Blue Skies theme call everyone from governments and corporations to civil society and individuals to **Invest in #CleanAirNow**. This initiative aimed to maintain clean air in Odisha through green infrastructure, public awareness campaigns, and technological innovations.

State Pollution Control Board, Odisha observed the International Day of Clean Air for Blue Skies 2024 in its Head Office and six Regional Offices for seven non-attainment cities.

2.1 Bi-cycle Rally

The State Pollution Control Board has organized a “Bi-cycle rally” in collaboration with the Centre for Environmental Studies (CES), FE&CC Department, Govt. of Odisha on the International Day of Clean Air for Blue Skies-2024. In this event Sri. Satyabrata Sahu, IAS, Addl. Chief Secretary, Sri Prem Kumar Jha, IFS, Director, Env.-cum-Spl. Secretary, Dr. K. Murugesan, IFS, Member Secretary, SPCB, Dr. Nihar Ranjan Sahoo, CEE, Er. Rabi Narayan Prusty, CEE, Er. Bijaya Kumar Behera, CEE, Dr. Sohan Giri, ACES-Cum-RO, Bhubaneswar, Er. Sitikantha Sahu, ACEE, Er. Dillip Kumar Dash, SEE along with the NCAP team, school students, local communities, and other dignitaries participated in the event and highlighted the theme “Invest in #CleanAirNow”. The main objective of this bi-cycle rally is to sensitise people to adopt environment-friendly lifestyles to reduce air pollution. A total of 200 participants including OSPCB officials, school students, and public people participated in this programme. T-shirts and caps were also distributed during the rally. 2.4 Environmental Awareness in Various Apartments

In order to improve air quality, SPCB and superhit 93.5 Red FM collaborated to conduct an extensive public awareness programme at 10 different apartments in Bhubaneswar and Cuttack by RJs of superhit 93.5 Red FM and Board officers intended for interacting and sensitising everyone in the community to adopt an environmentally friendly lifestyle. 4. Recommendations

- Air pollution is a significant issue, major contributing sources are vehicular, industry, road dust, solid waste burning, transportation, etc. To address this, stakeholders from various sectors should unite on a common platform, fostering a holistic understanding of pollution sources and formulating targeted strategies for emission reduction and enhanced air quality.
- Climate change is driving a focus on fostering behavioural change and promoting clean air, aiming to protect public health and the environment.
- Achieving clean air requires partnerships among stakeholders, substantial investment in air quality improvement, and active participation from individuals, communities, industries, and governments.
- Youth participation in awareness campaigns and sustainable initiatives is crucial for combating air pollution. Odisha is strengthening data governance for informed policy formulation and decision-making.
- Climate governance and adaptation efforts are addressing climate change challenges, with initiatives promoting sustainable practices.
- A comprehensive approach to air quality management involves critical evaluation, monitoring, source apportionment studies, hotspot zone identification, improved response systems, and capacity building.
- Increased funding will expand ground-based monitoring stations and integrate advanced modelling tools.
