

PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING MEETING HELD ON 28.05.2025 AT 11.00 A.M. AT DANAGADI BHAWAN, DANAGADI IN JAJPUR DISTRICT FOR ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE IN RESPECT OF M/S SIRIUS SPECIALITY CHEMICALS PVT LTD (WHOLE SUBSIDIARY OF SANVIRA INDUSTRIES LTD) FOR PROPOSED GREENFIELD COAL TAR DISTILLATION UNIT OF CAPACITY 2,00,000 TPA AND 1,00,000 TPA CARBON BLACK WITH 11 MW OF CO-GENERATION POWER PLANT AT VILLAGE JAKHAPURA UNDER DANAGADI TAHASIL OF JAJPUR DISTRICT, ODISHA.

The public hearing in respect of proposed by M/s Sirius Speciality Chemicals Pvt. Ltd. (Whole subsidiary of Sanvira Industries Ltd.) for proposed greenfield coal tar distillation unit of capacity 2,00,000 TPA and 1,00,000 TPA carbon black with 11 MW of co-generation power plant at village Jakhapura under Danagadi tahasil of Jajpur with reference to

- I. EIA Notification S.O 1533 (E) Dtd. 14.09.2006
- II. Interim Operational Guidelines till 13th September 2007 in respect of applications made under EIA-1994

The Panel consisted of the following members:

Sri Sapan Kumar Nanda, Additional District Magistrate, Kalinganagar supervised & presided over the public hearing process and assisted by Er. Madan Mohan Sahoo, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Kalinganagar, the representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

At the outset, welcoming the members participated in the meeting Er. Madan Mohan Sahoo, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Kalinganagar, gave a brief introduction about the guidelines to be followed for the public hearing in the light of EIA Notification, 2006 and interim operational guidelines till date, in respect of project proposed by M/s. Sirius Speciality Chemicals Pvt. Ltd. (Whole subsidiary of Sanvira Industries Ltd)

Welcoming the public, Sri Sapan Kumar Nanda, Additional District Magistrate, Kalinganagar explained that the views, comments, objections and opinions of the

public are necessary while considering the environmental clearance of the project. He asked the project proponent to make a brief presentation before the public gathered in the meeting about the various aspects of the proposed project to be undertaken for better awareness of the public.

Mr. B. Patanjali, representative of M/s Sirius Speciality Chemicals Pvt. Ltd. (Whole subsidiary of Sanvira Industries Ltd) greeted the committee members and assembled public. He briefed about the project and seek everyone's cooperation. He requested the Visiontek Consultancy to give a detailed presentations of the proposed project. Mr. Rameswar Behera representative of the Visiontek Consultancy greeted everyone and briefed about the silent features of the proposed plant, environmental safety, water management, environmental management, pollution control measures, waste management, afforestation programme, health programmes, skill development programmes, employments and various other peripheral development activities envisaged in the proposed project.

Sri Sapan Kumar Nanda, Additional District Magistrate, Kalinga Nagar requested the public to give their views, comments, objections and opinions on the proposed project.

The views expressed by various speakers on the proposed project are as follows:

1. Shri Sanjay Kumar Mohanty (Manitira Village)

He fully supports the industry that M/s Sirius Speciality Chemicals Pvt. Ltd which is proposed to establish. He hoped the industry will give prioritize the local people and he requested to adopt Hi-technology for pollution control measures.

2. Shri Prashanta Kumar Ray (Danagadi Village)

He greeted everyone present at the public hearing. He said that he was delighted to be from Kalinga Nagar, which is known as the industry hub all across the world. He briefly addressed the history of welcoming in 17–18 different industries in kalinganagar area since MESCO in 1992. They are welcoming the industry in their area. He shared his opinions about the current government and how industries are encouraged so that opportunity for creation of jobs generated. He told that local people will be get benefitted. He recommended that the industry will consider the interest of their local region in both the environment and jobs. He requested to the district government for massive plantations for environment protection as required. Plantation & employment is necessary for the self of local people. Employment

generated are not adequate for local people. He requested to the industry that they should take care the interest of local people who were present in the public hearing for support of the industry. He told that the economy of their region as well as state and country economy will enhance because of industrialization. Lastly he supported the proposed project and requested others to support the project.

3. Shri Pratap Kumar Dhir (Danagadi Village)

They welcomed the proposed project which will be established at Jakhapura village of Danagadi block. He shared his thoughts that economic development of the local peoples arise in the Sukinda, Kalinganagar and Duburi region to Chandikhol. He told that they welcomed the proposed project but the commitment provided by the project proponent should be carried out for the benefit of the local people. He requested the authority to control the pollution generated during transportation in their area. He concluded by thanking everyone.

4. Shri Rajendra Kalundia (Chandia Village)

He expressed his support to the proposed public hearing of M/s Sirius Speciality Chemicals Pvt. Ltd.

5. Shri Deepak Kumar Mohanty (Balungabandi Village)

He greeted everyone. He mentioned that in previous years, they have welcomed various industries but they have not gained any benefit, works as well as employment opportunities locally. He told that the local people are not getting employment opportunity but the outsiders are finding employment opportunity. He expressed his concern about the dust pollution in their area and its impact might affect future generations. He asked the industrial authority about the percentage of local employment they are taking from the affected villages. He completely opposed the project.

6. Shri Malaya Sahoo (Jakhapura Village)

He greeted everyone. He claimed that the residents of Jakhapura village are being opposed to get entry into the public hearing to give their opinion. He questioned that how a coal distillation power plant will be allowed near to Jakhapura village which is within a distance of 200 to 500 meters from habitation. He asked whether plantation activity will be carried out prior to construction or after operation of industry. Finally, he expressed his strong opposition to the proposed project.



7. Shri Sudhansu Sekhar Bhanja (Danagadi Village)

He greeted the chairperson and everyone present in the public hearing. He expressed his complete support towards the public hearing of M/s Sirius Speciality Chemicals Pvt. Ltd. However, he requested that the district administrations shall look after the promises made by the companies in their areas with respect to education, health, employment, and community development initiatives. He told that Kalinganagar will become an industrial hub and their future generation will see the complete Kalinganagar industrial hub. So he requested the district administration for peripheral development of local areas.

8. Shri Balaram Ayach (Kumbhiragadia Village)

He greeted the chairperson and everyone present in public hearing. He shared his thoughts through a poem indicating that the forthcoming project will lead to industrial growth, economic growth, pollution control measures shall be implemented and jobs will be created.

9. Shri Laxmi Ballav Samal (Kumbhiragadia Village)

He greeted everyone. He expressed his thoughts over the developments of the region will reflect in local development as well as individuals. And lastly he gave his full support to the project.

10. Shri Ramachandra Pahi (Jakhapura Village)

He expressed his support for the upcoming project; however, he raised concern that the commitments made by the industries are not being fulfilled. The benefits are not reaching the local communities and those who have lost their land are not getting employment opportunities. Local land loser people are also not getting education and health facility. They are supporting the project and requested to look after their children education, health, increase in plantation activity as pollution control measures.

11. Mrs. Bratati Samal (Jakhapura Village)

She gave her complete support to the Public Hearing & told the project proponent for taking consideration about education, health, local employment and the environment.

12. Shri Santosh Kumar Samal (Manoharpur Village)

He completely supported the Public Hearing of M/s Sirius Speciality Chemicals Pvt. Ltd. & he expressed his perspective on how industrial development contributes to social advancement and local development.

She has also been failed to produce evidence on her local resident proof, owning her control over the project w.r.t application submitted for environmental clearance, persons likely to be affected by the project or any involvement of her organisation in the field of environment, and any local authority within any part of local limits within the neighbourhood wherein the project is proposed to be located, so she has been refused to speak by the chair.

26. Shri Rama Chandra Dhal (Jakhapura Village)

He greeted everyone and completely supported the Public Hearing. He requested project proponent for their commitment to set up ETP & STP. He requested the District Administration to look after the environment & local employment.



27. Shri Bulu Yadav (Pingal Village)

He expressed his gratitude to District Administration, print media, and others who have attended the public hearing. He stated that the significance of the public hearing process, highlighting the roles of the Regional office and SEIAA. He supported the project proposed by M/s Sirius Speciality Chemicals Pvt Ltd. He then inquired with the chair about the utilization of NCAP funds for the installation of sprinkler systems. Furthermore, he asserted that there is an insufficient forest area to support the population of 1,800 elephants. He urged the industry authorities to undertake the planting of Neem trees and other indigenous species. He asked about the employment opportunity to local people on skilled basis. Lastly, he questioned the authorities regarding the ETP, plant capacity, and the implementation of zero liquid discharge. He completely supported the project.

Road Dust & vehicular pollution 		<p>Sri Nihar Ranjan Panda, Project Manager of M/s Sirius Speciality Chemicals Pvt Ltd made commitment to certain issues raised by the public are as follows:</p> <p>He extended his gratitude to the chairpersons, Police personals, print media & everyone present.</p> <p>He committed & assured to offer Local Employment with respect to their educational qualification.</p> <p>He stated that as per the government guideline, there is mandatory for green coverage of 33% of total area of the industry area with plantation but they have committed to do plantation over 35% of the total industry area with indigenous local species.</p> <p>He stated that their power plant will be not coal based power plant, they have proposed for waste heat recovery boiler type power plant to generate electricity and they will not use coal as raw material. He explained that the waste gas produced by the process is having higher temperature; if this gas is released into the atmosphere, temperature in the surrounding area will rise. They will use the waste heat to create steam, which will then be fed into a turbine to produce power. No coal will be used in this process and ash will not be generated. He promised</p>

that the power plant they have proposed will not cause any harm to the surrounding area.

He assured that they will implement zero liquid discharge and not a single drop of process water will be discharged to outside. He informed them that the process water will be treated in the treatment plant and the treated water will be again recycled in the process.

He promised that they would create a green belt all along the industry boundary in accordance with the guidelines to reduce noise pollution.

In order to suppress the road dust produced by vehicles, he promised to provide water sprinkling provision all along the road.

Lastly, he expressed his gratitude to everyone.
