

PROCEEDING OF THE PUBLIC HEARING MEETING IN RESPECT OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT FOR M/S. PALRIWAL INDUSTRIES PRIVATE LIMITED, FOR INSTALLATION OF COAL TAR DISTILLATION UNIT OF CAPACITY- 1,20,000 TPA WITH 15,600 TPA HIGH QI COAL TAR PITCH TO MANUFACTURE 70,800 TPA BINDER GRADE PITCH, 34,800 TPA ANTHRACENE OIL, 9,600 TPA TECHNICAL NAPHTHALENE, 2,400 TPA LIGHT OIL, 4,800 TPA PHENOL OIL & 9,600 TPA WASH OIL AT VILLAGE DEOGAON UNDER MANESWAR TEHSIL OF SAMBALPUR DISTRICT HELD ON DT. 18.07.2025 AT 11.00 A.M AT BANPUR FOOTBALL GROUND, DEOGAON IN SAMBALPUR DISTRICT.

Sri Sudhansu Kumar Bhoi, OAS (S), Additional District Magistrate (Revenue), Sambalpur presided over the meeting in the presence of Dr. Satya Narayan Nanda, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Sambalpur.

While welcoming the public present in the meeting, Dr. Satya Narayana Nanda, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Sambalpur also briefed them about the objective of the public hearing being conducted under the provisions of EIA Notification No. S.O. 1533 (E) of Dt.14th September 2006 of the Ministry of Environment and Forests & Climate Change (MoEF & CC), Government of India.

He also informed that the date, time, and venue for conducting this public consultation meeting for Sambalpur district was duly advertised in one Odia daily newspaper, '*Prameya*, dt. 23.06.2025, and in one English daily newspaper, '*New Indian Express*' dt. 23.06.2025 following due procedure for intimation of the public. The venue, date, and timing of the public hearing meeting was also extensively propagated through loudspeaker announcements in the area on dtd 15.07.2025 by the Board. Executive summaries of the proposed project both in Odia & English were displayed at the meeting venue for ready reference of the public and were also distributed among the persons present during the meeting. The executive summary was also made available on the website of the State Pollution Control Board, Bhubaneswar (www.ospcboard.org). (Paper clippings are enclosed as **Annexure-I**).

The Additional District Magistrate also briefed about the proposed project and requested the public who were present during the public hearing meeting to express their opinions and views on the proposed project. Before deliberation, ADM request to the project proponent to briefed about the project before the public.

Sri Vishal Palriwal, Director of M/s. Palriwal Industries Pvt Limited, welcomed the public and requested support from them for the proposed project. He introduced, Sri Rameswar Behera, Environmental Consultant of the proposed project for detail

deliberation about the project. Sri Behera welcomed the public and extends warm greetings and heartfelt gratitude to all attendees. He informed that, the proponent going for the establishment of a Coal Tar Distillation Unit with an annual capacity of 1,20,000 tons at Deogaon village under Maneswar Tehsil, Sambalpur District, Odisha. This project proposes to produce: Coal Tar Distillation unit of Capacity – 1,20,000 TPA with 15,600 TPA High QI Coal Tar Pitch to manufacture; 70,800 TPA Binder Grade Pitch and 34,800 TPA Anthracene oil, 9,600 TPA Technical Naphthalene, 2,400 TPA Light Oil, 4,800 TPA Phenol oil & 9,600 TPA wash oil.

The project is standalone and does not rely on any inter dependent units. Sri Behera, stated that the proposed project to be developed on 5.799 hectares of land at Dhama village, Sambalpur district with a water requirement of 67.01 cubic meters per day. About 40 personnel will be get employment opportunity in the project.

The environmental consultant Sri Behera, acknowledge the possibility of adverse environmental effects, such as dust, smoke, impacts on topography, and biodiversity. However, effective mitigation strategies have been proposed to ensure environmental safety and ecological balance.

Further, he stated that the project will be established according to the environmental guidelines. The project will take proper care of environment by adopting air pollution control measures, effluent management with an ETP of 20 KLD, maintaining Zero Liquid Discharge (ZLD) model and other waste management. Over 33% of the total area will be under green belt with fast-growing native species, selected in consultation with the local horticulture or forest department.

The Company places high priority on social welfare and peripheral development. It will support local education, healthcare, family welfare, self-employment, drinking water supply, rural sports, and community growth. The proposed project is expected to bring notable economic, social, and cultural development to the locality.

Then, the Regional Officer invited the public to offer their views on environmental-related issues for the proposed project.

About 70-80 participants attended the public hearing meeting and out of them 28 participants have put their signatures in the attendance sheet whose list is annexed as **Annexure-II**. 18 persons have registered their names to deliver their views out of them 17 persons delivered their views during the public hearing and the list is annexed as **Annexure-III**.

Statements of the public participated in the deliberation during the public hearing meeting are as follows:

Sl. No.	Name and address of the Participants and their deliberation on the proposed project.
1	Sri Sudhir Pradhan, Deogaon: He questioned the distance between village Deogaon and Banpur saying it is 4 kms distance and No announcement was made regarding today's public hearing. He said, the village Deogaon has struggled to construct and build one Panchayat High School. The location of the factory from the school is just 10 meters away. The industry and its pollution will hamper the students. The village is mostly of Tribal and <i>Harijan</i> community and the students will be affected if factory is constructed and students will remain deprived of basic education. He opposed the factory establishment in the area.
2	Sri Rakesh Bhoi, Deogaon: He said no notice along with announcement through loud speaker was conducted in the area regarding today's public hearing. No information was available to them. He opposed the factory's establishment in the village. He said he does not want the so-called development of the village when it comes to establishment of a coal tar pitch factory. He questioned why Soil Test was not done in this matter. He expressed his concern that the school in which his son goes to if it gets affected by factory pollution then he has to shift his son to school in Dhama and not in Deogaon. Dhama is far away and chances are there of accident. Then a 4-way road is to be made he questioned? He further said there will be air pollution and there are 25 villages within 05 km radius and all villages will be affected. He strongly opposes the industry instead of their green agricultural fields.
3	Sri Alekha Pasayat, Deogaon: He said that if the industry is established then all agricultural fields will be destroyed and strongly opposed the establishment of factory in the village.
4	Sri Upendra Baghar, Gour Goth: He said he is a Bonafide resident of village Deogaon. The Sarpanch and the ward members if agree then he will also agree to the establishment of the factory.

5.	Sri Mangal Oram, Gainpura: He said he is agreeing with the rest of the villagers in opposing the establishment of the factory.
6.	Sri Siba Bhue, Gainpur: He questioned sarcastically whether factory establishment in their village will really bring development to their village? He said the ward members have conspired against the village and acting for the establishment of the factory. It is ill fated.
7.	Smt Raibari Seth, Deogaon: She said that if factory is allowed in their village. the nearby school will be damaged and destroyed. Where will the poor children go for their basic schooling, she questioned? She strongly opposed the factory establishment in their village.
8	Sri Manmath Bhoi, Deogaon: He said he is from the Deogaon GP and respect and welcome the local administration. He also stated that he is the Previous Sarpanch of the village and even though his mother has expired he has left the rituals and has come to assist the village in this matter. He strongly opposed the establishment of this coal tar pitch factory in his village and it is not his desire but the desire of the entire village to shut down the factory and requested the administration to not permit it for operation in his village. He also said no vehicle making announcement was heard regarding today's public hearing. No information available regarding today's public hearing.
9	Sri Sanjaya Kumar Deep, Deogaon: He said he belongs to Deogaon GP. He stated on example of an industry in Kenghati area. Where there is pollution due to industry. He said since some people travel by car and do not feel the impact of pollution but common man like him travel on road feel the impact of pollution very closely. It causes irritation. He strongly opposed the establishment of the factory.
10	Sri Banchanidhi Seth, Degaon: He questioned the proposed factory and the village High school distance. He strongly opposed the establishment of the factory.
11	Smt Asili Seth, Deogaon: She said small children go to the high school which is nearby to the proposed factory and she does not want the factory in her village or near to the school. She strongly opposed the establishment of the factory.

12	Sri Sriram Bhoi, Banpur: He said that he resides in the Banpur village. The establishment of the factory will destroy the educational institute. If an educational institute will be destroyed where is the world headed to, he questioned. He strongly opposed the establishment of the factory.
13	Sri Subash Badi, Gainpura: He said he is from Deogaon GP. He wanted to know through which agent or organisation has all this meeting of public hearing has been arranged? He strongly opposed the establishment of the factory. He questioned the role of village sarpanch and the 11 ward members involved in this act.
14	Sri Soukial Ray, Deogaon: He said he is from Deogaon GP. He said Deogaon people are Adivasis and Dalits. The village high school has been constructed by the village with a lot of effort. And what is the distance between the factory and the school? He questioned why the village Sarpanch did not inform them regarding the public hearing. The 11 number of ward members signature has been copied and this has been allowed or permitted. He strongly opposed the establishment of the factory.
15	Sri Furjan Kujur, Tal: Absent
16	Sri Suryajit Bhoi, Dhama: He said that the mothers and ladies of the village are opposing the factory now when it is already established and half constructed is over. They should have opposed it initially in the beginning before any construction activity. He questioned that development doesn't happen for poor people? Should the poor remain as dust. He said the factory is constructed in front of the Deogaon Panchayat school. He said the factory should be established in their village.
17	Sri Jharu Kumbhar, Deogaon: He said he belonged to Deogaon GP. He said the Deogaon GP High school is near to the proposed factory. He said why the project proponents selected this site? Whether the land is suitable or not? why a boundary wall was made before consulting any locals? why the villagers were not asked and involved before any construction activities he said. He said that they have seen videos of coal tar pitch factory and it causes air pollution for environment. Air pollution is poison. School is nearby. He strongly opposed the establishment of the factory.

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They are not happy with the factory establishment and despite their unhappiness the govt. is taking action. The local people are opposing the factory. They are not happy with the factory establishment. The factory people promise so many things but after establishment nobody comes to fulfil such promises. Again, they will continue to remain as farmers and live their life in sorrow and in pain but will not allow the school to be affected because it was made with great effort by Gangadhar Mohapatro, Rajbihari Nayak, Lingraj Das and such people went to collect money from villages for establishment of the school and now they will not permit it to be destroyed. He strongly opposed the establishment of the factory.

- 18 **Smt. Samari Majhi, Deogaon:** She said that the village people will carry loads of firewood, carry earth and do other labour work and send their children to school for studies but will not allow the factory to be established in their village. They will eat salted rice and send their children to school for their bright future but will not allow the factory to be established in their village. If Govt. wants to help the villagers, then she demanded to give them employment but without factory establishment in their village. She strongly opposed the establishment of the factory.

Summary of the points raised by the participants in the public hearing are being read out by Dr. Satya Narayan Nanda, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Sambalpur and same in English and Odiya (vernacular language) is enclosed as **Annexure-IV (A & B)**. Further, he clarified that State Pollution Control Board, Odisha has not yet given any permission to the proposed unit for its establishment.

After completion of the deliberation process the Regional Officer invited the representative of the project proponent to reply to the point raised by the participants in the public hearing meeting.

On behalf of the project proponent, Sri Rameswar Behera, Environmental Consultant gave a brief note on the issues related to the demand and grievances raised by the participants which are given in English and Odiya (vernacular language) in **Annexure-V (A&B)**. The video recording of the entire proceeding of the public hearing is enclosed as **Compact Disc (CD)**.

After the above-mentioned deliberation, Sri Manoranjan Pradhan, Assistant Environmental Scientist, Regional Office, State Pollution Control Board, Sambalpur, Odisha proposed the vote of thanks to the Chair as well as to the Participants present in the meeting. Lastly, the Additional District Magistrate has announced the completion of public hearing meeting.

The meeting was ended with vote of thanks to the Chair.

The public raised the following issues and apprehensions for redressal by the project proponent.

1. Adequate pollution control measures should be taken in the proposed project so that local people should not get affected due to the environmental pollution.
2. The public raise objection that the Deogaon High School is very near to the factory site and it will affect the functioning of the high school.
3. District Administration and State Pollution Control, Board not widely prorated the venues and date to conduct the public hearing to the local people.
4. The unit has not conducted soil testing before the installation of the Plant and the Agricultural activities will badly affect due to operation of the Plant.


